Background

The RUFORUM Agricultural Innovation Hackathon Initiative (RAIHI) launches its inaugural national edition in Botswana to institutionalize a replicable model for agricultural innovation discovery and commercialization across African universities. This initiative targets deep-tech solutions that address agricultural productivity, climate resilience, and value chain efficiency. Through a structured innovation-to-market pipeline, student-led ventures and startups will transform ideas into field-validated Minimum Viable Products (MVPs), culminating in live pitches to investors and corporates at the RUFORUM AGM.

Overall Objective:

To catalyze the discovery, development, and commercialization of deep-tech agricultural innovations that enhance climate resilience, market access, financial inclusion, and productivity for smallholder farmers, especially women, across Botswana and the RUFORUM university network.

Specific Objectives

- Identify and support scalable agricultural innovations aligned with climate-smart practices and inclusive market systems.
- Equip early-stage ventures with product development and commercialization skills.
- Facilitate investor and corporate engagement for pilot partnerships and funding.
- Showcase Botswana's capacity for grassrootsdriven, tech-enabled agricultural transformation.
- Empower women farmers and youth innovators through tailored digital solutions.
- Workshop Participants
- University students, young researchers, and earlystage startups from Botswana.
- Technical, commercial, and impact-focused judges from academia, industry, government, and RUFORUM.
- Investors, corporate partners, and cooperative leaders attending the RUFORUM AGM.
- RUFORUM Innovation Talent Pool (ITPs) and selected finalists for the hackathon showcase.

Expected Outcomes

- Development and exhibition of MVPs addressing four thematic areas: market access, digital finance, precision farming, and advisory systems.
- Seed funding and post-hackathon support for winning teams, including mentorship, technical resources, and investor introductions.
- Strengthened innovation ecosystem linking universities, agribusiness, and grassroots communities.
- Enhanced visibility and commercialization of climate-smart agricultural solutions across RUFORUM's network.

Approach

RAIHI adopts a multi-stage pipeline:

- Pre-AGM Masterclasses: Focused sessions on product development and investor readiness.
- 2. Selection & Judging: A 9-member panel evaluates applications using weighted digital scoring.
- Demo Day: Finalist's pitch lives to investors and corporates, with real-time feedback and Dealroom integration.
- Post-Competition Support: Winners receive seed funding, incubation, mentorship, and partnership facilitation over 12 months.
- Thematic Design: Innovations are curated around Naledi's persona a representative woman farmer ensuring relevance, inclusivity, and impact.
